

Dear Parishioners.

Christ is Risen! He is truly Risen! A very happy Easter to everyone! Easter brings such a sense of Joy and renewed Hope, a Hope that is echoed in nature with the bursting forth of new life in this beautiful season of Spring.

What a blessed Holy Week this has been, beginning with our Holy Week Mission given by Fr. Glenn Sudano, C.F.R. How grateful we are to Father Glenn for his engaging and inspiring talks, and for the time he gave us. It was a wonderful way to bring Lent to its culmination and to lead us into the Sacred Easter Triduum these last three days.

We have just spent these last holy three days with our Lord Jesus in His final moments on earth. On Holy Thursday night, the night before He suffered, we were with Him in the upper room at the Mass of the Lord's Supper where Jesus gave us the supreme gift of the Eucharist, the Priesthood, and a beautiful example of humble service when He bent down and washed His Apostles' feet. From Holy Thursday Night until the Easter Vigil the Tabernacles in all the Churches throughout the world were empty and the Mass was not celebrated. The whole Church paused to remember the death of the Lord. How sad life would be if this were the end of the story. How hollow and empty our existence would be if the Tabernacle was always empty, if the Church did not exist, if we did not have our faith. But today the Church throughout the world proclaims with a resounding Alleluia: Christ is Risen!, He is truly Risen! Death is swallowed up in victory. Good has triumphed over evil, love has triumphed over hate, life has triumphed over death.

How marvelous and powerful is our Faith, and how beautiful is our Parish of St. Francis Xavier because of all of you. How encouraging and uplifting it was for Fr. Shanthi and I to see the overflowing crowds at Mass and so many coming to Confession during these holy days. If anyone reading this message today has been away from our parish or from the Church we welcome you home and hope you will remain with us. We need you so much.

On behalf of all the priests and staff of St. Francis Xavier I want to wish all of you once again a very blessed Easter. And I thank you from the depths of my heart for your faith, your love, your prayers, and your support. Your presence here with us week after week is most precious to us. Know that we love you and are here to serve you. May God bless us all.


