Dear Parishioners,

We welcome this weekend Saul Llacsa, a second Pastor year Seminarian at St. Joseph's Seminary who will be speaking at all the Masses on this "Good Shepherd Sunday." Through the Prophet Isaiah, God

promised: "I will give you Shepherds after my own Heart." Let us pray for Saul and all of the young men at St. Joseph's preparing for the Priesthood, that they persevere in becoming shepherds after the Heart of Jesus. Let us pray, too, that more of our young may be open to the possibility that Jesus may be calling them to a life of service in the priesthood or religious life.

Every year on this Fourth Sunday of Easter we are given the image of Jesus as the "Good Shepherd." For thousands of years throughout the Old Testament the Jewish people were given the image of God as their Shepherd. We hear in the beautiful 23rd Psalm: "The Lord is my Shepherd there is nothing I shall want." Jesus fulfills this ancient prophesy in today's Gospel as He speaks of Himself as the Good Shepherd: "My sheep hear my voice; I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish." There are so many other voices out there that seek to drown out the Voice of Jesus and His Church, false shepherds who lead so many astray, especially our young people. Only Jesus can lead us safely through this world to the green pastures of Heaven. If we are not following Him, if we are not listening to His Voice, we are going to lose our way in this difficult and morally confused world.

On this Good Shepherd Sunday and with the release of Pope Francis' Apostolic Exhortation last week on the Jov of Love in the Family, this is a good time to bring up a pastoral issue that is guite prevalent these days regarding marriage. In speaking of the Spirituality of Marriage and the Family, Pope Francis writes: "The Trinity is present in the temple of marital communion...God dwells deep within in the marital love that gives Him Glory...If a family is centered on Christ, He will unify and illumine its entire life. Moments of pain and difficulty will be experienced in union with the Lord's Cross, and His closeness will make it possible to surmount them." The Pope speaks beautifully here of the importance of the Sanctifying Grace of the Sacrament of Marriage which helps a marriage and family to remain strong, happy and holy through all the trials that come with living. How close our Lord, the Good Shepherd, wants to be to married couples and families.

The reality is that, today so many couples are living without the Grace of the Sacrament of Marriage for many different reasons. I just want to extend a heart-felt invitation to assist any of our couples who are not married in the Church for whatever reason toward celebrating the Sacrament of Marriage. We are here to help you. The process of having a civil marriage con-validated in the Church is much easier than most people think.

If a prior marriage and divorce has necessitated a couple to be married civilly outside the Church, please let us help you to try to have the prior marriage declared Null and Void so that you are free to celebrate the Sacrament of Marriage, that is have your current con-validated. Pope Francis has amended the Annulment Process to make it much more accessible than it seemed before. The process now is much simpler, faster, and it is free of charge. Again, please let us help you. Fr. Reiman and I are here for no other reason than to help our people come closer to God. May St. Francis Xavier always be a place where the Love of Jesus is present and felt by all every day. May God bless us all.
